VANCOUVER – Archbishop J. Michael Miller will offer a Scripture reading Canada Day Monday as thousands of Christians gather to pray for their country at a massive prayer rally at Rogers Arena.

The Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Vancouver is one of numerous Christian communities and interdenominational ministries that will gather at Voices Together; Lift High the Name of Jesus.
